

Fold it in half landscape



Fold down the right top corner to make a triangle



Rip off the

extra paper at the end of

the triangle

Open the triangle to a square







Fold the edges

Rip the rectangle in half to make

2 squares

of the square to meet in the middle







Take one paper and fold the Repeat step 8 and you will top into a triangle and repeat have 2 pieces folding until it looks like this like this



Take the other piece of paper and fold the top into a triangle going the opposite way from step 10 and repeat until it looks like the other







Take both papers and on the side with the line, put them together



Fold the triangles over the other paper and tuck them into each corner

You're finished! It takes a lot of practice to be good at folding paper. If you mess up don't feel down about it. Keep trying and never give up.

Sometimes you have to use tape or glue if you cant tuck it into the corners.


